The Enhancing Student Learning Report is designed to focus on system wide continuous improvement, enhancing student outcomes and life chances for every student in BC. With a particular emphasis on Indigenous students, children and yout the innext students with disabilities and/or diverse abilities, schools and districts are required to have multi-year plans, submitted to the Ministry of Education and Childcare on an annual basis. Additionally, the Burnaby School District has incorporated that English Language Learners, beginning with the 202-223 report.

The Enhancing Student Learning Report is also intended to support Boards of Education in the development of strategic plans as well as provides a framework by which districts can reflect on and adjust practice and share progress publicly.

Deputy Superintendent, Roberto Bombelli, will provide an overview of the District's 22022 report summarizing the data and findings.

The final report, once approved, will be submitted to the Ministry of Education and Child Care by October 3, 2023.
