SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT Reporting to Public Session on Tuesday, January 30, 2024

1. Indigenous Education in Burnaby Schools

Annually school districts across British Columbia receive targeted funds for the delivery of enhanced services for Indigenous students. Burnaby School District's Indigenous Education Department provides a continuum of targeted service recently announced that support key commitments include the service service

<u>Plan</u> and the <u>BC Tripartite Education Agreement</u>. Bill 40 is aimed at improving First Nation student learning outcomes through the development of effective relationships and processes with local First Nations. There are three main elements of the new legislation and policy: Local Education Agreements, Indigenous Education Councils and First Nations School of Choice.

Assistant Superintendent, Brandon Curr, will provide an overview of the Indigenous Education Department in the Burnaby School District, as well as share information from the Ministry of Education and Child Care relating to Bill 40.

Recommendation:

2. Registration and Student Planning for the 2024/2025 School Year

Student Registration is a cyclical process that occurs every school year and is defined by Policy #5.05 in the Burnaby School District's Policy Manual.
